### Direct Debit Guarantee



- This Guarantee is offered by all Banks and Building Societies that take part in the Direct Debit scheme. The efficiency and security of the Scheme is monitored and protected by your own Bank or Building Society.
- If the amounts to be paid or the payment dates change, BAHT will notify you 14 working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed.
- If an error is made by the BAHT or your Bank or Building Society, you are guaranteed a full and immediate refund from your branch of the amount paid.
- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by writing to your Bank or Building Society. Please also send a copy of your letter to us.

*Gift Aid it*

Using Gift Aid means that for every pound you give, we get an extra 25 pence from the Inland Revenue. You must pay an amount of Income Tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that BAHT reclaims on your membership in the tax year (currently 25p for every £1.
